>Due to the numerous amendments and additions to the pool motion, we did not address the remaining motions the membership wanted a vote on. First is the more than a quorum approved increase in dues to \$250. Please put this on the next meeting agenda so the ballot can go out and the appropriate increase in dues can be billed in 2013.

>The ballot could read in part,

>Given our obligation to maintain our facilities and in recognition that our dues have been insufficient to maintain our facilities for some time and insufficient to provide any reserves for unexpected and expected expenses, the Board proposes, and a quorum of the membership has already approved, a dues increase to \$250. We believe this is the minimum needed to to maintain our facilities and to establish a reserve which we desperately need to ensure we do not permit our facilities to further deteriorate.
