Practice of Law Board

The Practice of Law Board was created by the Washington State Supreme Court in 2001 to investigate [unauthorized practice of law complaints](#), [issue advisory opinions](#), and recommend to the Supreme Court ways nonlawyers can improve access to [law-related services](#). The Board has 13 members appointed by the Supreme Court. At least four board members must be non lawyers. The Practice of Law Board investigates complaints about the unauthorized practice of law. These complaints include nonlawyers advertising legal services, nonlawyers pretending to be lawyers, unsupervised paralegals offering legal services, and out-of-state lawyers representing Washington residents when not authorized. The Board received many written, phone, and email inquiries about what law-related services nonlawyers and out-of-state lawyers can perform. If you would like to
