While the Board funded 5k for the architect to do an evaluation of the building, the results of such wouldn't seem to be necessarily essential to the question of whether the pool is open-able this year. That is, might the building be okay this year and reworked per the plan next year? The pool guy's evaluation of plumbing etc. would seem to be more salient to that question; so when can we get something from him? I think most of the members of the committee would like to drill down on that question, and one way or another put it to rest or get cranking. How about Sunday afternoon?

And one just so we're all on the same page, the motion passed unanimously at the annual meeting has our committee working with the Board to craft the vote initiative, and I believe we are still operating under that Feb 28 mandate requiring an answer to the above question.
