Chris –

Attached is the release that you prepared with my edits shown as redline changes. I clarified the fact that we are only releasing the individual board members from claims or liability as part of this transaction. The section relating to the current board was not part of our agreement nor are they parties to the lawsuit. Just so it's clear, my client has no intent to sue the current board members about the pool. He wants to proceed with his declaratory judgment action and have a determination (by agreement or otherwise) that is consistent with Judge Hancock's earlier ruling plus some additional detail. Releasing the current board will only create confusion about our ability to proceed with the Dec. action so I am not willing to recommend or approve that.

I would like to proceed by having Mr. Wilbur sign the release in the attached format. He will do so ASAP and deliver those releases to me. The releases and a signed/approved order of dismissal with prejudice will be provided to you upon my receipt of the \$10,000 check. I would just as soon proceed in that manner rather than involve Vasu's clients any further.
