Dear Board: In light of Judge Hancock's recent ruling regarding the pool assessment and the ACBC responsibility to maintain the pool, I am formally requesting a comprehensive pool status report be made at the December Board meeting.

Over the last few months, I have made several requests of the Board to refill the pool and take appropriate precautions to safeguard the pool from damage and maintain it consistent with the bylaws, the RCW and WAC regulations. When I checked over the Thanksgiving weekend the pool did not appear to be in compliance.

Now that we have the rulings made by the court there should be no more doubt or delay in taking appropriate action to winterize the pool and protect it from damage.

Therefore---this is a formal request, as an ACBC member and a Plaintiff in the lawsuit, that the board act immediately to safeguard the pool and make a detailed report at the December Board meeting regarding the actions taken.
