Hi Trina,

After talking things over, we've decided to leave the pool main pump running round the clock to keep the water circulating and chemicals as mixed in as possible.

I've a request in to 3 pool equipment suppliers for estimates to get the chlorinator, Watermatic, peristaltic pump and skimmer lids fixed. Heater was checked by AmeriGas on Friday and found some leaks and no start of pilot. We'll leave that alone until a qualified tech can check. I've a call in to Barron Heating for an estimate to fix gas control issues, leaks and rewire.

Harry Lynam will be checking once a day to be sure all is OK with circulation system. If he discovers any significant problems he'll shut the pump off and get in touch with you - he has your phone number.

It would be nice if you'd give him a call to let him know when you'll be at the pool so he won't have to come down those days. His phone number is 678 1183.

If you need to get in touch with me, best to call my cell phone - 360 969 2205. I'll be in Michigan, from tomorrow evening until the morning of June 3, so would appreciate no calls after around 7pm WA time.

I did leave a copy of all the Stratum VRS device manual and trouble shooting list on the counter in the Pool office - if you need.

Harry will not be opening the pool office - doesn't have a security access number.

Hope all stays under control while I'm away.

Obviously, not sure if we'll open this year or not, depends on a number of issues but are glad you're interested in helping maintain the system if we do - we're pleased with your expertise and effort.
