**AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW
CAUSE RE: CONTEMPT**

(Clerk's action required)

This matter came before the Court upon Plaintiff's ex parte motion for the entry of an order directing the Defendants, and each of them to show cause why they should not be held in contempt of this court for violating the court's order entered in this matter on September 11, 2013. The Court heard argument from Plaintiff's counsel, Christon C. Skinner, and considered the Motion for Order to Show Cause and Supporting material, the declaration of Robert Wilbur, the declaration of Gwyn Staton and a proposed Order to Show Cause re: contempt.

Based on the records and files herein, the argument and evidence presented, the Court finds that:

1. A temporary restraining order was entered in this case on September 11, 2013 and the Defendants have been duly served with a copy of the order. The

1 Defendants are represented by counsel, Vasu Addanki, who has appeared in this case
2 on behalf of all Defendants.

4 2. The Plaintiffs have made a prima facie showing that the Defendants or some
5 of them, may have taken willful action in violation of the Temporary Restraining Order
6 previously filed.

8 3. The Defendants should be required to appear and show cause why the court
9 should not enter an order of contempt and provide other relief in the form requested by
10 the Plaintiffs in their motion.

11 Based on the above findings, it is **HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

12 The Defendants above named, including a representative of Admiral's Cove
13 Beach Club, shall appear and show cause, if any they may have, why they should not
14 be held in contempt for violating the court's order of September 11, 2013 and further
15 why the sanctions and other relief requested in the Plaintiffs' motion should not be
16 granted. A hearing has been set for the following date, time and place:

23 **the relief requested by Plaintiff may be granted without further notice.**
