| Latest update,

At this point we have a good possibility of open next week as long as the State gives it's blessing next Monday. A few last minute things should be completed over the weekend.

Some less than good news though. Our automatic water controller, chlorine and Ph, appears to be defective as noted by Northwest Hot Springs technician. We can adjust these levels manually, but will require constant water monitoring by the lifeguards and/or pool manager. We would have to close swimming to add these balancing chemicals for the water to circulate this cocktail though. (Chlorine and Muriatic acid.)

We can order a new controller that would be delivered by next Friday. The cost is just over \$1800, which includes 2 new sensors, does not include shipping or installation. Ed and I believe the this system would work with the new pool renovation, but can't be sure at this point.

We are very close to the \$5000 budget that was allocated to the pool opening this year. We haven't filled the propane tank either. (\$1700 more)

What are your thoughts about spending an additional \$2100-2200 for a new Polaris Watermatic controller.

We would not order unless we pass the State inspection. We would need to order before 5 Monday to get it by Friday the 15th.

Please respond before Saturday the 9th.

Wish I had better news this late in the game, but the pool looks amazing!
