Well, I'll try to explain in a short few sentences about the happenings here at Admiral's Cove. I have attached the two ballots we have been circulating with excellent feed back. We now have over 50 signed ballots for both the pool and removal of the problem board members. Just so you know we have requested that the ballot be changed to reflect the desires of this large representation of the community and the board majority of 4 has refused to make suitable changes. If all else fails we are asking members to sign the second ballot as well and we will present this at the general meeting on October 27, 2012 if all else fails. We will then ask for the resignation/removal of the four members mentioned. We are being encouraged by the three minority members of the board who have not been included in any of the meetings, discussions, writing of ballots or discussions on the issues. The current appointed president is running for the board this election. She was appointed after the board removed a member for "no cause" last fall and then appointed to her to the president slot. This is the vote that makes the majority.

We are planning to submit the cover letter and the ballot tomorrow so it can be mailed with the entire packet as an alternate pool ballot that reflects a less oppressive presentation. Our concern is that their wording will precipitate the closing of the pool which is contrary to our understanding of the ACBC mission. I will also attach the final draft of their ballot regarding the pool for your comparison. They have refused to consider re-classifying the pool as "Limited Use" rather than "General/Public Use" or to have a tiered membership platform for those who don't want to use the pool. The results are that this board majority refuses to consider any modifications that may help us to keep our pool and make it affordable.
