Just wrote to Trina and asked her to turn pumps on again until Friday. Harry or I will check level later today. In a conversation with Trina yesterday she said that the main reason that the pool was closed last year was the fire and gas leak in the heater. She said that the pool lost some water, but not a lot. This is a different narrative than I remember...I thought it was because it was grossly leaking and then the fire happened.

Anyway, the filter system will be on until Friday. I wonder at what point we should ask Alex to go down to take a look at the heater. At a meeting last night Maria wanted to show us pictures of the bubbles on the heater coils indicating gas was leaking because the pipes were not tightened correctly causing the resulting fire. We were not too interested in seeing those pictures at this time...I'll keep you posted.

G'afternoon,

Just went down to look at the pool and everything seems fine except for some rocks thrown on the deck. Trina called this AM as she was loading and starting the filtering system. It looks pretty good right now...about 8 hours in. The fill line is about 1" down from the top line of tiles so it looks pretty much like it did yesterday.

We will keep an eye on it. Monday we get Wifi and will set up a camera in the Shelter to look at the pool from that side and will probably put another in the office looking out. I'll go down again later this afternoon to see that things are okay.

There is a big party down there today with bouncy house etc. I'm not sure but I think they are not "in" the shelter...just outside but lots of cars and kids. That makes my heart sing. Just need to make certain that they clean up.
